- ❑ Internship begins April 23
- ❑ The Cath Lab Internship program will be individualized based on experience. During the internship, all interns will be assigned to the day shift, which could be 8-hour shifts during initial training and 10-hour shifts during 500hrs clinical orientation. Participants should not be taking any other programs or courses during the internship.
 - The RN with Critical Care or Emergency Department experience may attend components of the Critical Care Internship program based on identified learning needs. They will also complete Cath Lab didactic and 500 Clinical Hours in a Level II Cath Lab.
 - The RN with Progressive Care Telemetry / Post Interventional Care will complete the Critical Care Internship Program, Cath Lab Didactic and 500 Clinical Hours in a Level II Cath Lab.
- ❑ Upon completion of the program, you will resume to work on the shift and the unit you were hired for (no exceptions). Available openings and shifts are based on the needs of the unit.
- ❑ There is a two-year required commitment for this internship program, specifically to the Cath Lab that hired you to participate in the program, beginning at the end of the Cath Lab training and 500 Clinical Hours.
- ❑ Candidates selected for the program will be notified by March 30.
- ❑ Panel interviews will be conducted by unit managers from March 19-23.

Preferred Experience: 1 year of critical care or ER experience or 2 years of Telemetry or progressive experience with a referral from a cath lab manager.

Required Licensure: FL RN License

Required Certification: BLS (and EKG course must be completed prior to start date. Certification or transcripts will be required to interview.)

Completion of an EKG course is required for the program. You can apply for an EKG course through the Online Learning Center via the Intranet. If you have not completed an EKG course in the last three years, it is recommended that you enroll in a class before applying for the program. You must pass the EKG course with an 80 percent. You are allowed two attempts during the first couple weeks of the program.
